

Life Problems: General

Check existing conditions which deplete all Life Desires.

- **Leaks**

Front door/back door alignment

Bathroom in center of house

Stairway out front door

Living on top of a mountain

- **Imbalances at front door**

Narrow path to the front door

Blocking tree or column

Split at front door

Blocking wall at front door

- **By creating “danger” & “overwhelm”**

House at the end of a cul-de-sac or "T Intersection

House too close to the front of the lot

Entry below street level

Towering, oppressive building

House built on "Boot" or "Cleaver" shape lot

House with Split-levels especially with narrow stairs between

Bed and stove back to back

Stove can be seen from entry

Double "T" intersection

Deserted houses close by

Bedroom door not working properly.

- **Multiple missing areas of house**

Cross shape known as "Wounded Dragon"

"U"- shape, "L"- shape, "H"-shape

- **Limiting opportunity**

Hidden doors

Narrow windows

Facing the wrong direction

Stove in a corner

- **Imbalance in the Five Elements**

Fire in the center of the house

"Fire house" in a "Water environment"

i.e. A-frame at the beach ("Water destroys Fire")

Structural Elements

- Splits
- Knife edges
- Hidden Doors
- Arguing Doors
- Contrary Doors
- Biting Doors
- Empty Doors
- Dead Doors
- Piercing Heart Doors
- Doors on slanted walls
- Sharp angles
- Unbalanced slanted ceilings
- Low heavy beams
- Narrow windows
- Incorrect wiring producing electromagnetic fields

Bagua Elements

- **A missing Gua (directional sector)**
this may be good depending on Flying Stars
- **A bathroom directly in a Gua**
- **A Destructive Five Element sequence**
 - *Swimming pool in Fame (Water destroys Fire)*
 - *Fireplace in Children (Fire destroys Metal)*

Check existing/planned enhancements to Life Desires:

- **Use enhancing Color**

Good: Red in Fame

Bad: Grey in Career

- **Use corresponding Gua element**

Good: Water in Career

Bad: Metal in Family

- **Constructive Five Element Cycle**

Fountain in Family (Water feeds Wood)

Wood desk in Fame (Wood feeds Fire)

White in Career (Metal feeds Water)

- **Use of a physical Feng Shui adjustment**

- **Use of a “Secret Cures” adjustment**

- **Imagination and decorative artistry**

Checking *Fame*

- Your reputation at work,
- Your good name in the community,
- Your honesty and integrity,
- the way your children see you,
- the way you see yourself,
- and every “recognizable” energy in-between.

Fame: *Check existing or planned depleting conditions*

- **Buildings:**

Knife edge of neighboring building angled at house

Deserted buildings nearby

- **Roads:**

Double "T" intersection

Roads curving away from the house both in front and to the right side.

- **Lot:** *Lot which narrows at back*

- **Room Arrangement:**

Entry facing an angle especially in a diamond shaped lot

Large garage out front

Bathroom over main entry.

Fame: Interior Elements

- **Doors:**

Blocked doors

Empty doors

Hidden doors

- **Windows:**

Blocked windows

*Windows that slide up
and down (rather
than open out)*

Slit-like windows

- **Other:**

Knife edges

Overhangs

Blocked hallways

Closets in Fame

*House systems not
working properly*

Fame: Furniture Placement

- **Vulnerable bed placement:**

Back to door

In line with door

Surrounded by doors

Not facing front door

Facing knife edge

- **Vulnerable desk placement:**

Same as above

Back to knife edge

Desk with back too close to wall

Checking *Partnership*

- Your relationship to your life partner,
- business partner,
- the Divine,
- and to yourself.

Partnership: Check existing or planned depleting conditions:

- **Roads:**

Entry below street level

House at end of cul-de-sac

- **Lot:**

Lot with uneven sides

- **House Shape:**

"U"-shaped house with entry inside the "U"

- **Room Arrangement:**

*Master bedroom, kitchen and dining room in
front of front door*

*Home office in Partnership especially if
work is all-consuming*

Unattached rooms behind the house in Partnership

Relationships: Interior Elements

- **Entry:**

Split at front door

Split stairway at front door

- **Bedroom:**

Contorted path to bedroom

Ceiling beam running the length of marriage bed

Lack of headboard

- **Doors: The "voice" of the adult**

Piercing Heart Doors

Biting Doors

Arguing Doors especially in bedroom

Many doors in master bedroom

Empty Door between master bedroom and master bath

Relationships: Furniture Placement

- **Furniture Placement**

*Stove in Partnership area of an extension
in Partnership .*

- **Other**

Checking **Children**

- **Your own children,**
- **Other people's children and the child within.**
- **Your vision and creativity,**
- **Your imagination and artistry.**

Children: Check existing or planned depleting conditions:

- **Buildings:**

Neighboring roof line pointing at house

- **Roads:**

House at "V" intersection House at "Fork" intersection

- **Lot:**

Corner of swimming pool pointing at master bedroom

Children: Room Arrangement

■ **Entry**

*Entry facing an angle
especially in
triangular lot*

Split at front door

*Bathroom opposite
entry door*

*Division of house
into two halves*

■ **Bedrooms**

*Children's bedrooms in
front of front door*

*Children's bedrooms
over garage*

*Children's bedrooms at
"bottom" of*

Children: Interior Elements

- **Windows: The voice of the child**
Size and number of windows out of balance with doors
Blocked windows
Windows that don't open
Narrow windows
Broken windows

- **Other**
Split stairway at front door or long narrow hallways
Double doors opening out
Fireplace in Children
Beam or overhang over child's desk
Stuffed closets, drawers and storage areas especially in Children

Children: Furniture Placement

■ **Desk**

Desk with back to door

Desk that is too small or too big

Desk facing knife edge

Sitting with back too close to wall

■ **Other**

Cluttered horizontal surfaces

Mirrors that cut off head or slice through body

Checking *Helpful People*

- Those who pay you money, give you money, fix your plumbing and bring you knowledge.
- Your circle of friends.
- Your willingness to ask for help when you need it.

Helpful People: Check existing or planned conditions:

- **Roads:**

Entry below street level

- **Lot:**

Lot sloping away from house

Lack of flowing water

Narrow path to front door

- **Room Arrangement:**

Kitchen seen first from entry

Dining room too close to front door

Guest room in commanding position

Helpful People: Interior Elements

- **Doors: The voice of the adult**

Hidden Doors especially main entry

Too many doors

Dead Doors

Doors that don't open all the way

Squeaky doors

Stuck doors

Helpful People: Furniture Placement

■ **Bed**

*Bed out of commanding position
Bed under window*

Bed without headboard

■ **Desk**

*Sitting at desk with back to window
Sitting in open-backed chair*

■ **Other**

Dining table in front door/back door alignment

Conversation

areas in line

with door

especially front door/back door alignment

Checking **Career**

Check existing or planned depleting conditions:

- **Buildings:**

Towering, oppressive building especially if built after house

- **Roads:**

Fork" intersection

Entry below street level

Contorted or depressing path to home

Career: Check existing/planned depleting conditions:

■ **Lot:**

House too close to front of lot or to much water

House facing uphill

Driveway which narrows at the end

Narrow path to front door

Only path to street blocked by garage

■ **House Shape:**

"U"-shaped house with entry inside the "U"

■ **Room Arrangement:**

*Stove seen first upon entry Bathroom over entry "Buried"
home office*

Career: Interior Elements

■ **Doors**

Biting Doors

*Contrary Doors
in the office*

■ **Other**

*Square columns both
inside and out*

Split at front door

Blocking walls

*Uneven or creaking
floors*

Career: Furniture Placement

■ **Desk**

*Desk under slanted ceiling,
overhang or beam*

*Desk in line with or back to
door*

Desk surrounded by doors

Desk too small or too big

Desk under toilet

*Cluttered horizontal
surfaces including the
desk*

■ **Bed**

*Foot of bed under
beam*

*Bed on lower
level of split-
level room*

Checking *Knowledge*

*Not just what you know,
but your ability
to use what you know.*

Knowledge: Check existing/planned depleting conditions:

- **Buildings:**

Entry below street level

- **Lot:**

Too much water "moving" or "still"

- **Room Arrangement:**

Bedroom seen first from entry

Game room seen first from entry

Splits

Bedroom at "bottom" of house

"Buried" study

Knowledge: Interior Elements

- **Oppressive entry**
- **Many beams in one room especially study or bedroom**
- **Unbalanced slanted ceilings**
- **Stuffed closets, drawers and storage areas**
- **Too much light**

Knowledge: Furniture Placement #1

- **Desk**

Desk under slanted ceiling

Overhang or beam

Desk with back to door

Desk in line with door

Desk that is too small or too big

Knowledge: Furniture Placement

#1

- **Other**

Not enough spacious, clean horizontal surfaces

Too many doors especially in study and bedrooms

No books in sight

Broken or dirty mirrors

Mirrors which are too low or too high

Lack of strong centers

Lack of "quiet "spaces

Checking *Family*

Your own family,

Your extended family,

Your family at work

**Or play and the entity that is
formed by family members, such
as a book club or baseball team.**

Family: Check existing/planned depleting conditions:

■ **Buildings:**

Corners of adjacent houses facing one another

■ **Roads:**

Entry below street level

"V" intersection

"Fork" intersection

■ **Lot:**

Lot with uneven sides

Family: Room Arrangement

- **Stove: Key to family prosperity and harmony**

*Stove seen first from entry or with cook's back to door;
Stove in center of house or facing to outside of house;
Stove with door on both sides and Stove in corner.*

- **Other**

Division of house into two halves

*Master bedroom, kitchen **or** dining room in front of front door*

Contorted path to bedrooms

Children's bedrooms outside front door especially if very young or in commanding positions

Family: Interior Elements

- **Doors: The voice of the adult**

Front door/back door alignment; Arguing Doors; Biting Doors; Piercing Heart Doors; Small hallway with many doors; Too many doors or Very large doors.

- **Windows: The voice of the child**

Too many windows (more than 3:1 with doors); Very large windows.

- **Other**

- Beams in a narrow hallway especially if many doors

Family: Furniture Placement

- **Vulnerable placement of beds and desks**
- **Formal seating arrangements in family areas**

Checking **Wealth**

*the flow of money
and thoughts
about money
in your life.*

Wealth: Check existing or planned depleting conditions:

■ **Buildings:**

Bridge pointing at house

Towering, oppressive building especially if built after house

■ **Roads:**

Road curving away from house

Roads curving away from the house both in front and to the right side Entry below street level

House at "Fork" intersection

Wealth: Check existing or planned depleting conditions:

■ **Lot:**

Shape and Placement:

Lot which narrows at back

Lot sloping away from house

Square placement on an L-shape lot

House facing uphill

Water. Symbolic of money

River or pond curving away from house

Flow of river away from house

Muddy or stagnant water

Corner of swimming pool pointing at house

Wealth: Check existing or planned depleting conditions:

- **Other.**

House overly exposed to elements

Driveway which narrows at the end especially if out of sight Blocking tree or column especially square columns Narrow path to front door especially if it narrows at street Narrow, steep steps which lead away from front door

- **House Shape:**

House with small entrance - a "Nose" house

Wealth: Room Arrangement

- **Bathroom: Money down the drain**

Bathroom in center of house

Bathroom on midline

Bathroom facing kitchen

Bathroom opposite entry

- **Other**

Entry facing an angle especially in triangular lot

Front door opening out

Dining room door not working properly

Game room seen first from entry

Narrow dark kitchen on midline

Uneven or creaking floors

Wealth: Interior Elements

- **Doors:**

Front door/back door alignment

No back door especially at business location

Two facing bathroom doors

Door at end of long hallway

Front door opening out

Piercing Heart Doors

Doors that are either too small or too large

Stairway out front door

Back door in Wealth

- **Other**

Beams over stove or dining table

Blocked hallways

Wealth: Furniture Placement

- **Stove: Key to family prosperity**

Stove burners oppressed by microwave oven hood or pots

Stove in a corner

Cook's back to door or with a door on both sides

Stove in Wealth area or extension in Wealth

Stove, bed or desk in toe of "Boot"-shaped room or house

Stove burners not working or not being used

- **Toilet**

Conspicuous toilets

Toilet and stove back to back

Toilet and bed back to back

- **Other**

Checking ***Health***

***without which
none of the rest
is possible.***

Health: Check existing/planned depleting conditions:

- **Buildings:**

House located across from church

Funeral home or cemetery

Bridge pointing at house

Comer of a building pointing at house especially front door or bedroom.

- **Roads:**

Double "T" intersection

Roads curving away from the house both in front and to the right side.

Health: Check existing/planned depleting conditions:

■ **Lot:**

House too close to river or other body of water or too close to front of lot especially if rounded at back

House facing uphill

Blocking tree or column

Dead plants at front door or cut trees

Corner of swimming pool pointing at house

■ **House Shape:**

"U"-shaped house with entry inside the "U"

House with small entrance - a "Nose" house

"Cleaver"-shaped house especially if bed, desk or stove is on knife edge

Health: Room Arrangement

- **Entry:**

*Entry facing an angle especially in diamond shape lot
Division of house into two halves or into two halves on
a diagonal.*

- **Bathrooms:**

Bathroom seen first from entry

Bathrooms or kitchen on midline

Bathroom over kitchen especially if toilet above stove

Bathroom at end of a long hallway

Bathroom opposite entry door

Bathroom in center of house

Two facing bathroom doors

Bathroom above bedroom especially if toilet above bed

Health: Room Arrangement

- **Bedrooms:**

Bedroom facing a bathroom especially if Empty Door between

Bedroom seen first from entry

Bedroom over garage

Contorted path to bedroom

Bed on lower level of split-level room.

- **Kitchen & Stove:**

Kitchen the first room upon entry

Front door, then kitchen door, then stove even if not direct

Road, then front door, then kitchen door, stove even if not direct

See stove first upon entry.

Health: Interior Elements

- **Doors:** Openings for movement of vital energy in and out & Symbolic of the head

Blocked doors

Piercing Heart Doors

Contrary Doors

Biting Doors

Awkwardly placed doors

Front door/back door alignment

Troublesome front door

Double doors opening out

Many doors in small space

Health: Interior Elements

- **Staircases: Moving vital energy up and down**
Spiral staircase at or near center of house especially if added in remodel
Spiral staircase at front door
Stairs without risers
Narrow stairs between split-levels
- **Hallways: Pathways of vital energy**
Blocked hallways
Slanted hallway especially to bedroom or bathroom
- **Ceilings: Container of vital energy**
Unbalanced slanted ceilings
Low ceilings
Beams over dining table or bed

Health: Interior Elements

- **Windows:** Openings for movement of vital energy & Symbolic of the eyes

Blocked or broken windows

- **Other**

Blocking Walls

Knife edges

Malfunctioning water or electrical system

Imbalance in Five Element colors especially too much white

Health: Furniture Placement

- **Bed:**

Bed with feet out door

Bed under window especially if liver problems

Bed without air circulation between mattress and floor

Bed and stove or toilet back to back.

- **Desk.**

Desk with back to door or in line with door

Desk in line with knife edges.

- **Other**

Mirrors that cut off head or slice through body

Furniture too close to fireplace.
