Flying Star Feng Shui

- Examines Feng Shui forces over time
 - Time influence is in 20 year periods, yearly and/or monthly
- Uses specific formulas based upon earth rhythms mathematically symbolized by the LO SHU square
- Reveals the lucky & unlucky sectors of buildings
- Its analysis is based on direction, numerical systems, and elemental relationships
- It has the most profound Feng Shui influence

The Steps: "Flying Stars 101"

- Understand the Original Lo Shu and the flight Path*
- Determine in which era your house was built or had major renovation in and create "Base Star Chart*"
- Determine the exact compass direction your front door faces
- Determine what is the water star (Yang: facing direction) and the mountain star (Yin: sitting direction)
- Depending on Yin (-) or Yang (+) direction of your home within 15 degrees: fly the mountain and water star in ascending (+) or descending directions*
- Overlay your "Star Chart" on your floor plan in the right directional orientation and analyze the numbers according to the energies of the 9 sectors
